Here is a list of things you will need to bring:

- Clothes! (*bring clothes for various weather conditions, and bear in mind that it can be cold at night.*)
- You might like to bring extra socks, woolly jumper, track suit bottoms, gloves, hat to wear at night
- Carrier bag for dirty washing
- Some kind of waterproof coat in case it rains.
- Good walking shoes/trainers
- Wellington boots or other waterproof shoes (*if you've got them – if not, a second pair of trainers would do*)
- Swimming gear (*including a towel*)
- Washing gear (*include a separate towel, soap, flannel, toothbrush, toothpaste, hairbrush etc.*)
- Sleeping bag and pillow and blanket (*or 2 It does get cold!! - your house has central heating – tents do not!*)
- Air-bed, camp bed or sleeping mat (*we can provide a sleeping mat & blanket if you haven't anything*)
- Hot water bottle (*if you get cold at night - we can also do the microwave sort*)
- Torch (*not essential*) There will be small torches for sale at the tuck shop for £1 or less
- Spending money for tuckshop & souvenirs - *but don't bring too much - £5 is plenty as you will not need it for anything else.* (We have Camp Mugs for sale at £3 each)
- Bible (*if you have one*)
- Please remember that no aerosols are allowed in the tents, as they destroy the waterproofing.
- Don't bring anything inflammable.
- N.B. Crockery & cutlery & tents etc. *are* provided!

Camp will finish on Monday at about 7pm. Parents and friends etc. can come any time after 5pm on bank holiday Monday. Visitors should bring a picnic tea, but drinks will be provided. There will be a final meeting at 6pm when the children will show off what they've learnt.
